If you are registering the DAY OF THE TOURNAMENT, please arrive between 8:00 and 8:15 to register.

TOURNAMENT SECTIONS: Both rated and unrated sections by grade based on registrations. Open to all Colorado scholastic students in grades K-12. Wyoming students are also invited to attend.

BYES: Players unable to attend the tournament for a certain round may request a “half-point bye.” This type of bye awards a player the same score as a draw. Up to two half-point byes may be requested but they must be requested before tournament play begins and are not available for the final round of play.

PRIZES: Trophies will be awarded to the top five players in each division.

LUNCH: Between round 3 and round 4 at the CSU food court.

SUPERVISION: **All players are required to have adult supervision.** Parents are responsible for arranging for the supervision of the players. Tournament Directors will supervise the tournament area. Parents will not be allowed in the playing area in the tournament room.
