High School Boundary Scenarios Reviewed by Committee

Discussion continued on four scenarios that would modify high school boundaries to better balance enrollment in Poudre School District at a Boundary Steering Committee meeting held in December. The committee has reviewed 19 scenarios to date. Committee members began analyzing student enrollment projections on 4 scenarios.

Please note that at this point, the committee may still create new, or revise current scenarios, based on student enrollment projections.

Steering Committee members will begin forming a boundary recommendation at a meeting scheduled for 5 to 7:30 p.m., Thursday, January 10, at the Johannsen Support Services Center, 2407 LaPorte Avenue.

Public input meetings will be scheduled following winter break where committee members, principals and school representatives will review proposed scenarios with the community. Public input meetings will be held at each high school location.

The Steering Committee, co-chaired by Jim Sarchet, PSD Assistant Superintendent of Business Services and Kellie Nuber, parent, includes principals, teachers and parents representing elementary, junior high and high schools. The committee also includes five non-voting support members (PSD staff and consultant). The Review Committee is comprised of parent/community members and principals or assistant principals from each school.

The two committees are studying high school boundaries with the goal of modifying boundaries to better balance enrollment in Poudre School District. The Steering Committee is developing possible scenarios and providing a boundary recommendation, while the Review Committee will give feedback to the Steering Committee. The next Review Committee meeting is scheduled for 5 to 7:30 p.m., Wednesday, February 13, at the Johannsen Support Services Center, 2407 LaPorte Avenue.
