**B. SIT/SAC – Deb Tucker** The school unified improvement plan was the topic at SIT.

The fall to winter MAP growth data for student progress was

– All students tested showed a collective 17% growth.

-Three of four grade levels have at least 75% of students at the proficient level.

-In math 2-5<sup>th</sup> grade students combined showed a 2% collective increase.

-The collective percentage of students in the proficient level is 66% compared to 75% in reading.

-In science the collective percentages of students at the proficient level are closer in range (within 7%) than in math or reading.

Midyear DRA 2 results show 189 students were tested K-3 158 scored at grade level or above. That is 84%

Fall to winter writing assessments show 140 made catch-up growth to grade level. 215(76%) students had grade level writing on the midyear assessment.
