Course Objectives:

Each Student shall:

- Learn technique and terminology for intermediate/advanced orchestral performance;
- Develop skills necessary to perform alone or in a group;
- Learn appropriate etiquette both as a performer and listener;
- Perform to the best of their ability;
- Develop music-reading and sight-reading abilities;
- Achieve a high level of performance through the development of tone quality, intonation, style, technique, balance, and blend appropriate to an intermediate/advanced ensemble;
- Increase musical understanding through the study of composers, music history, and the music of other cultures.

Class Expectations:

Each student shall:

- BE PROMPT
- BE PREPARED
- BE POLITE
- HAVE A P.M.A. (Positive Mental Attitude)
- PARTICIPATE
- PRODUCE (Take Care of Business)
- NOT chew gum or eat candy, or any other food/drink, in class.

Grading Policy:

In accordance with the Blevins Middle School Grading Policy, students will be evaluated on their performance related to established state and national content standards for Music:

- Assessment (90% of total grade);
- Practice (10% of total grade);
- Work Habits (reported each quarter, but not part of final grade).

Grades assigned will follow the adopted grading scale for Blevins Middle School:

- 4 (Advanced)
- 3 (Proficient)
- 2 (Partially Proficient)
- 1 (In Progress)
- 0 (Insufficient Evidence)

Supplies:

Students will be given a separate supply list.

Concerts:

Concert Orchestra participates in several concert events throughout the year. A separate calendar of concert dates has been provided, and the information is also available on the board in the Choir room (Room 203). **Attendance at all concerts is required.** Any conflicts with a concert date should be discussed with Mr. Floyd no later than two weeks prior to the concert. Any absence from a concert, excused or unexcused, will require makeup work.

Concert Attire:

Students in *Concert Orchestra* will wear black pants or floor length skirt (**no blue jeans, please**), and black shoes and socks (**no athletic shoes, please**). Students will purchase a shirt, tie, and cummerbund for around \$20 through the Blevins office. Please pay this fee as soon as possible so uniforms can be ordered.

Beginning Orchestra students will use the following book:

Essential Elements 2000 for Strings—Book 1.

We will use this book for the majority of the year. You may purchase this book for around \$9.00 at a local music store.

Symphonic Orchestra and Concert Orchestra students will use the following book:

Essential Elements 2000 for Strings—Book 2.

We will use this book for the entire year, along with concert literature. You may purchase this book for around \$9.00 at a local music store.

Instruments

Students are expected to have their instruments at school each class day. When students do not have their instruments, they cannot participate fully in the learning activities. The first time a student forgets his/her instrument, they will be required to call a parent/guardian to inform them of the situation. If the instrument is forgotten again, the student will be assigned detention to make up for the lost instruction time. Conferences between parents/guardians and Mr. Floyd may also be required.

Playing Tests

Students will be evaluated frequently to determine their skill level.

Material from the method books, scales, and excerpts from the orchestra concert literature will be used for the tests. Students are encouraged to retake the playing tests until they have mastered the material. **The goal for Blevins string players is to succeed!** Because playing in orchestra is a group activity, success by all students will ensure success of the entire ensemble.

- There will be a playing test from the method book or concert literature each week;
- Symphonic Orchestra and Concert Orchestra students will also have scales assigned during each quarter.

Most playing tests will be taken using Smart Music software. Blevins Middle School maintains several subscriptions to Smart Music for student use. However, it is highly recommended (but not required) that families purchase a subscription to Smart Music for use at home. More information is available at www.smartmusic.com or from Mr. Floyd.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR CHOIR AND ORCHESTRA STUDENTS/PARENTS REGARDING THE CARE AND RETURN OF MUSIC

The Blevins Music Department provides a substantial amount of music for student use during the school year. The cost of music used by our Choir and Orchestra groups is over \$3000 per year (some music is purchased new and some is from our existing library of music). Each year, copies of songs are lost, damaged, and even destroyed beyond use. This places an immense strain on the already small budget of the department.

In effort to control these losses, each student will be provided with a folder in which to keep his/her music. These folders will be assigned by number to the student, and the music inside will match the number of the folder.

Music will be turned in after each performance—or if the director decides that a piece of music is not suitable for the group.

Students will be responsible for returning the music loaned to them in good condition. Students who do not return music in good condition will be assessed the appropriate fee for the replacement of the music.
