Dear Eyestone Parents,

The end of the year has arrived! In looking ahead to our last week and in anticipation of the upcoming year, here is some information you may find useful:

Class Lists Posted: Class lists for the upcoming school year will be posted on the marquee in front of the school by 4 PM on Wednesday, August 10. This allows us to continue to balance classes after moves and new enrollments. (Registration for new students is on Monday and Tuesday, August 8 and 9.)

“Dessert” Social: Friday, August 19, 4:00 – 6:00 PM. This is our annual meet-the-teacher event (formerly known as the Ice Cream Social). Come and join the fun!

First Day of School: The first day of the new school year will be Monday, August 22 for students in grades 1-5 and Friday, August 26 for kindergarten students. (The later date for kindergarten allows for a week of assessments and conferences. Kindergarten class placements are made and communicated during this time in order to adequately balance classes and student needs.)

Back-to-School Nights: These will be held for grades 3-5 on Thursday, September 8 and for grades K-2 Tuesday, September 13. Times both evenings will be from 7:00-8:00 PM.

ECO Week for 5th graders will be held in mid-May 2012. We are moving our location from Pingree Park to Covenant Heights (up near Rocky Mountain National Park), which will offer us better facilities, services, and activities for students. Please look for further information from the 5th grade team after the start of the school year.

All-School Music Program: Thanks to all who filled out surveys to assist us in planning and improving this event! Next year’s program will be held at Poudre High School in their spacious auditorium. This will allow us to do just one evening program for all. (We’ll still do the smaller afternoon performance/dress rehearsal during the school day earlier in the week.) We’ll also have the two large music rooms at Poudre for dropoff/pickup/staging areas, and there will be plenty of parking available in the school lots. We have put in for several dates at points in the school year. Poudre High does not finalize their facilities schedules until later in the summer. Look for further information and updates this fall.
