All roads to Stove Prairie are paved. From the north end of Fort Collins, you will find us by going up Rist Canyon Road (CR 54E) to Stove Prairie Road (CR 27). Just go 14 miles west of Vern's Place in Laporte, up Rist Canyon and over the mountain, down the hill to Stove Prairie School. Please allow 45 minutes from the center of Fort Collins.

From the south end of Fort Collins, you can make the lovely drive around Horsetooth Reservoir to Masonville (CR 38E) and straight through, going up the Buckhorn Canyon (CR 27). (CR 38E becomes CR 27 at Masonville.) Continue on CR 27 for 14 miles to Stove Prairie School. Allow an hour from the center of Fort Collins.

From Loveland, go west on HWY 34 to CR 27 at Big Thompson Elementary. Go north to Masonville (about 6 miles). Turn left (west) at the Masonville Trading Post and go up the Buckhorn Road (thereby staying on CR 27). Stay on CR 27 for the 14 miles to Stove Prairie School. Allow an hour from Loveland.

From Poudre Canyon, turn south onto CR 27 at Stove Prairie Landing, about 14 miles west of Ted's Place. Go 5 miles on the paved road and you will find us!
